The Programme



EmpowerU is a transformative mentoring and outreach programme designed to support young people facing significant personal and social challenges. Our mission is to provide guidance, encouragement, and practical skills to help them navigate life's difficulties and build a positive, purpose-driven future.

The programme focuses on young individuals exhibiting behaviours such as low self-esteem, emotional struggles, challenging and disruptive behaviour, gang affiliation, anti-social tendencies, and general disengagement from education or society. We recognise that these behaviours often stem from deeper issues, including family breakdowns, trauma, peer pressure, and a lack of positive role models. Through targeted mentoring, outreach activities, and structured interventions, we aim to break negative cycles and instill confidence, resilience, and ambition in every participant.

Our Approach

One-to-One Mentoring

Each young person is paired with a trained mentor who provides consistent support, guidance, and encouragement. These mentors serve as role models, helping mentees set personal goals, manage emotions, develop problem-solving skills, and build a vision for their future. Through regular check-ins, our mentors create a safe and non-judgmental space for young people to express themselves, seek advice, and gain perspective.

Group Workshops & Life Skills Development

We offer dynamic group sessions that focus on key areas such as:

- Emotional Intelligence & Self-Regulation Helping young people understand and manage their emotions effectively.
- Conflict Resolution & Anger Management Teaching constructive ways to handle disputes and frustrations.
- Self-Esteem & Confidence Building Encouraging self-worth, self-belief, and a positive mindset.
- Career & Educational Support Assisting with job readiness, CV writing, interview skills, and educational guidance.
- Financial Literacy Teaching money management, budgeting, and financial responsibility.

Outreach & Community Engagement

Our team actively reaches out to young people in schools, youth centres, and local communities, engaging them through positive interactions and interventions. We collaborate with schools, social services, and local organisations to identify at-risk youth and provide timely support. Street-based outreach also allows us to connect with those who may not seek help themselves.

Gang Prevention & Intervention

For those at risk of or already involved in gangrelated activities, we offer specialised support that includes:

- Exit Strategies Helping young people leave gang life safely through alternative pathways.
- Violence Reduction Programmes Addressing the root causes of violence and providing conflict resolution tools.
- Peer Influence & Positive Role Models Introducing mentors and speakers with lived experiences to guide and inspire change.




Mental Health & Wellbeing Support

We recognise the importance of mental health and provide tailored support through:

- Counselling & Therapeutic Interventions Access to professional counselling for those struggling with trauma, anxiety, or depression.
- Mindfulness & Wellbeing Activities Techniques such as meditation, creative arts, and sports to promote emotional well-being.

Recreational & Personal Development Activities

Young people engage in structured activities such as sports, music, creative arts, and team-building exercises, all designed to provide healthy outlets for expression and self-discovery. These activities foster discipline, teamwork, and personal growth.y.






Our Impact

The Eight Principles

Young 'people should always be at the centre of the work that we do, they deserve to be respected, heard and supported to grow and develop. To Ensure that this is always the case we have built our services around the 8 key principles laid out by Ofsted.

These principles are:

- 1. I feel safe and secure where I live and in my wider environment.
- 2. My voice is respected, heard and advocated for, so I can influence the support I receive.
- 3. I have confidence that the adults who support me understand me, are skilled and work effectively together to best meet my needs.
- 4. I have my own space that I feel proud of and live in a comfortable, well maintained, and stable accommodation.
- 5. I receive high quality, tailored support that sustains my health and wellbeing.
- 6. I have strong, trusting, and meaningful relationships within my support system and can rely on the adults around me.
- 7. I feel empowered to learn and apply skills for independent adult living.
- 8. I feel positive about my future and opportunities as a result of the support I receive.






